Happy New Year! As we begin 2023 I want to do something I rarely do, suggest some commitments or re-commitments to make at the beginning of this new year. Normally I try to shy away from such things, because the practice of making "New Year's Resolutions" is rarely a highly successful venture. But this year I want to encourage you, not to make resolutions, but covenants with God. Begin each covenant with the statement, "As God is my helper, I covenant with him that I will..." What are the things that you believe God would have you covenant with him about in 2023? Here are a few ideas to think about and pray about.

Return to worship in person in 2023. During the COVID pandemic, we endeavored to make it possible for everyone to stay as connected to the Ridge family as possible. One of the ways we did that was by making our worship services available online each week. At first we streamed them live, then we began delaying them so that we could correct any technical issues. Lindsay Ray has worked tirelessly, sacrificed time off and engaged way above and beyond the call of duty to make these services available. I am personally grateful for her work, and for the fact that our services have been able to reach people in various parts of the United States and also several villages in Liberia where we have the chance to share the gospel online. Unfortunately, I think that for some people, having an online option has replaced the gathering in person, and watching a screen has NEVER been an adequate substitute for gathering with the people of God. This would be a good time to covenant with God that we will make worship in person a priority.

Commit to involvement in the work of the ministry of Ridge Baptist Church. This is another good place to consider covenanting with God. I anticipate that we will shortly have a new staff minister as part of the Ridge family. However, the addition of staff leadership is not a substitute for the involvement of the church family in the work of the ministry. We have some very faithful volunteers, but the faithful few are often overburdened with the work of the ministry, work that should be shared by the entire church family.

Commit to personal spiritual growth. This covenant is at the heart of what helps us be faithful, and what makes it possible to please God in the year ahead. A covenant with God to read the Bible through, or at least reading the scriptures designated daily in the weekly email, is a good start. We should always seek more opportunities to spend time with God in prayer, and a covenant to commune with God daily is a great one.

The result of keeping a covenant with God in the Scriptures was the abundance of his blessing. 2023 can be a year of blessing if we will make and renew covenants with God and follow through in keeping them. Join me in making 2023 a covenant year like none before!
